entities. The Commission has previously determined that large traders and FCMs are not "small entities" for purposes of the RFA.<sup>11</sup> The amendment to reporting requirements primarily impacts FCMs. Similarly, foreign brokers and foreign traders report only if carrying or holding reportable, i.e., large positions. The Commission invited comments from any firm believing that these rules would have a significant economic impact on its operations. No comments were received in response to that invitation,

## B. Paperwork Reduction Act

The Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995 (44 U.S.C. 3507(d)) (PRA), which imposes certain requirements on federal agencies (including the Commission) in connection with their conducting or sponsoring any collection of information as defined by the PRA, does not apply to this rule. The Commission believes that the rule amendment does not contain information requirements which require the approval of the Office of Management and Budget. The purpose of this rule is to establish a specific reporting level for security futures products.
