The two working groups will be formed from the merging of the previous four PAT working groups, which included: (1) Product and process development; (2) process and analytical validation; (3) chemometrics; and (4) process analytical technologies, applications, and benefits.

Procedure: Interested persons may present data, information, or views, orally or in writing, on issues pending before the subcommittee. Written submissions may be made to the contact person by May 31, 2002. Oral presentations from the public will be scheduled between approximately 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. on both days. Time allotted for each presentation may be limited. SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: On November 19, 2001, NIH OBA published a notice of amendments to the NIH Guidelines in the Federal Register (66 FR 57970). Those amendments became effective on December 19, 2001, except for the amendments to Appendix M-I-C-3 (Annual Reports) and Appendix M-I-C-4 (Safety Reporting), which were published for public comment to OMB regarding the paperwork burden of those information collection requirements. It was stated that those Appendices would take effect upon OMB approval. That approval was given on January 24, 2002.

Further, Appendix M-I-C-3 as published in the **Federal Register** on November 19, 2001 (66 FR 57970, specifically 57975), stated that the annual report to OBA is to be filed within 60 days of the date that the IND
