B. Submitting Comments

The NRC does not routinely edit comment submissions to remove identifying or contact information.

II. Discussion

The NRC is issuing for public comment Draft Supplement 17, Second Renewal, to the GEIS for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants, NUREG-1437, regarding the proposed SLR of Renewed Facility Operating License Operating License Nos. DPR-19 and DPR-25, for an additional 20 years of operation for Dresden. Draft Supplement 17, Second Renewal, to the GEIS includes a preliminary analysis that evaluates the environmental impacts of the proposed action and alternatives to the proposed action.

Based on the NRC staff's (i) review of the SLR application, which includes the environmental report, supplemental documents, and the licensee's responses to the NRC staff's requests for additional information; (ii) consultation with Federal, State, Tribal, and local governmental agencies and consideration of input from other stakeholders; and (iii) independent environmental review as documented in the draft environmental impact statement, the NRC staff's preliminary recommendation is that the adverse environmental impacts of SLR for Dresden are not so great that preserving the option of subsequent license renewal for energy-planning decisionmakers would be unreasonable.

Notice of application for an order under sections 17(d) and 57(i) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 (the “Act”) and rule 17d-1 under the Act to permit certain joint transactions otherwise prohibited by sections 17(d) and 57(a)(4) of the Act and rule 17d-1 under the Act.

SUMMARY OF APPLICATION: Applicants request an order to permit certain business development companies (“BDCs”) and closed-end management investment companies to co-invest in portfolio companies with each other and with certain affiliated investment entities.

APPLICANTS: Great Elm Capital Corp., Great Elm Capital Management, LLC, Great Elm Investments, LLC, and Great Elm Credit Income Fund, LLC.

FILING DATES: The application was filed on April 25, 2025, and amended on May 20, 2025.
